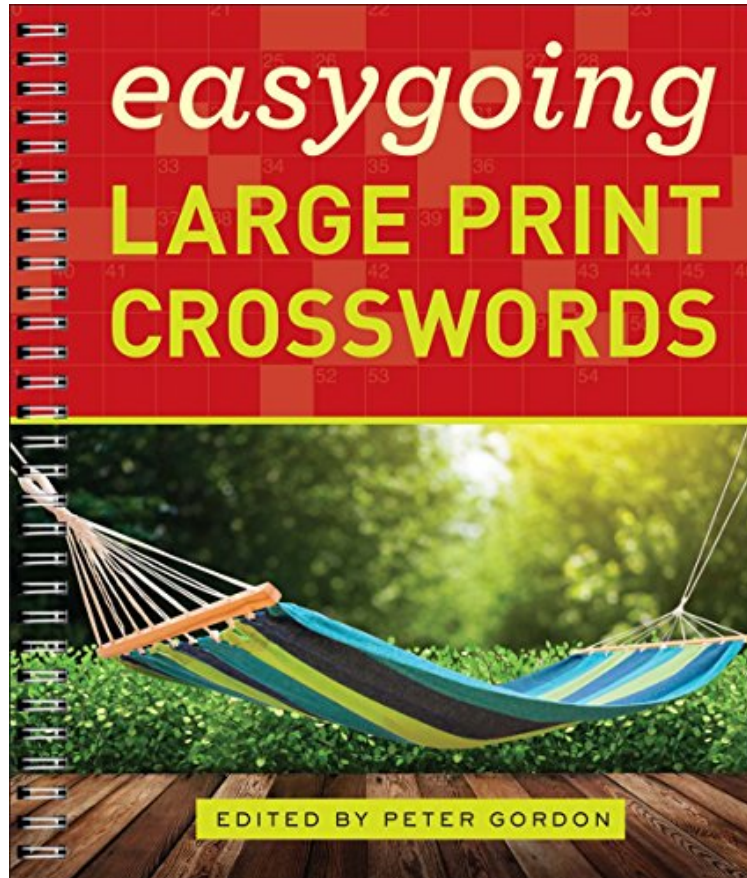

So I switch back and forth between several and this one was by far the easiest for me - almost too easy. But that was a relief I enjoyed as an occasional break from the 'easy' puzzles that ask questions like "Nation Once Known As Dahomey" and "1915 Literature Nobelist" - LOL!Like many crossword puzzles it is mostly aimed at Boomer-age trivia. Very suitable as a beginner/trial to see if you will enjoy doing crosswords or not.
