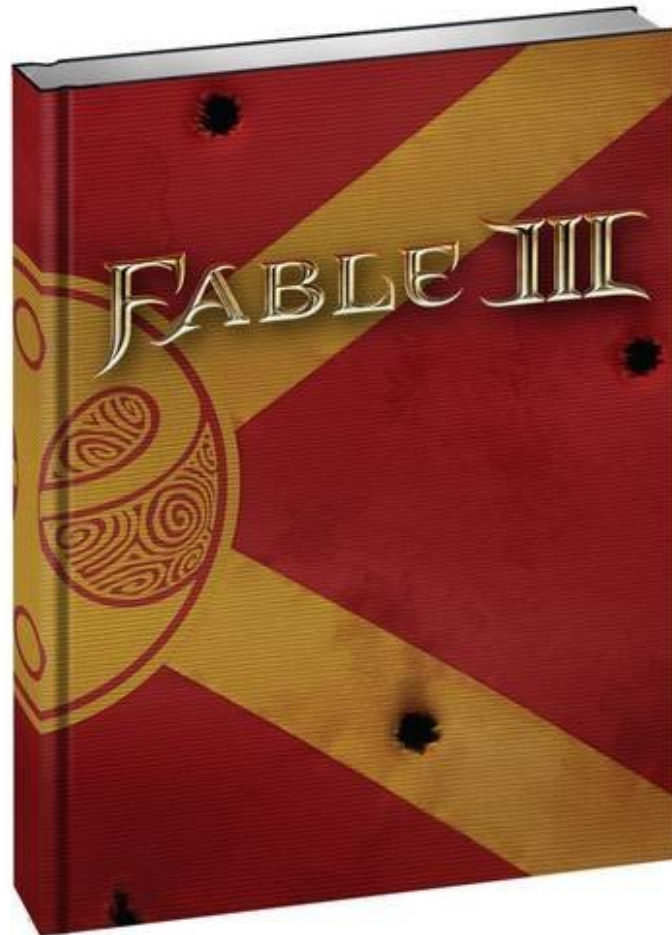

Comes with a tatoo code for 360 if you buy new (or unopened anyway). Not sure if code works for PC. . .google it, I would hope that it does,

but with the delay on PC release it may very well not. BTW the art gallery plus the dev commentary totals 96 pages...which is definitely awesome. Especially since, in such a simple game, that is probably the best part (if not useful, entertaining and worthwhile). The achievement guide is good, the maps are good, and basically everything (barring mistakes, tho they are at least pretty obvious) is a tad better than the game itself -- its worth it to me, but see the following. First Time Gamer - The internet will, ultimately, serve you better other than actual maps, but the descriptions and such on text guides suffices 99%, and video guides replace the rest. However, it covers everything but the heroic weapon morphs plenty well, so no reason not to use this, especially if you also fall into the next category. Collector - By now, you likely already have this, but I just got around to buying one myself so who knows. The it's pretty enough, wish the dust jacket were half as nice as the cover, but what can you do. the art section is goodly sized and plenty of pictures throughout -- tho they arent so helpful for guide-purposes, good for collectors to flip through. It's not amust have by any means, but cheap enough now, I paid 13 USD with 2-day shipping for mine, still shrinkwrapped.
