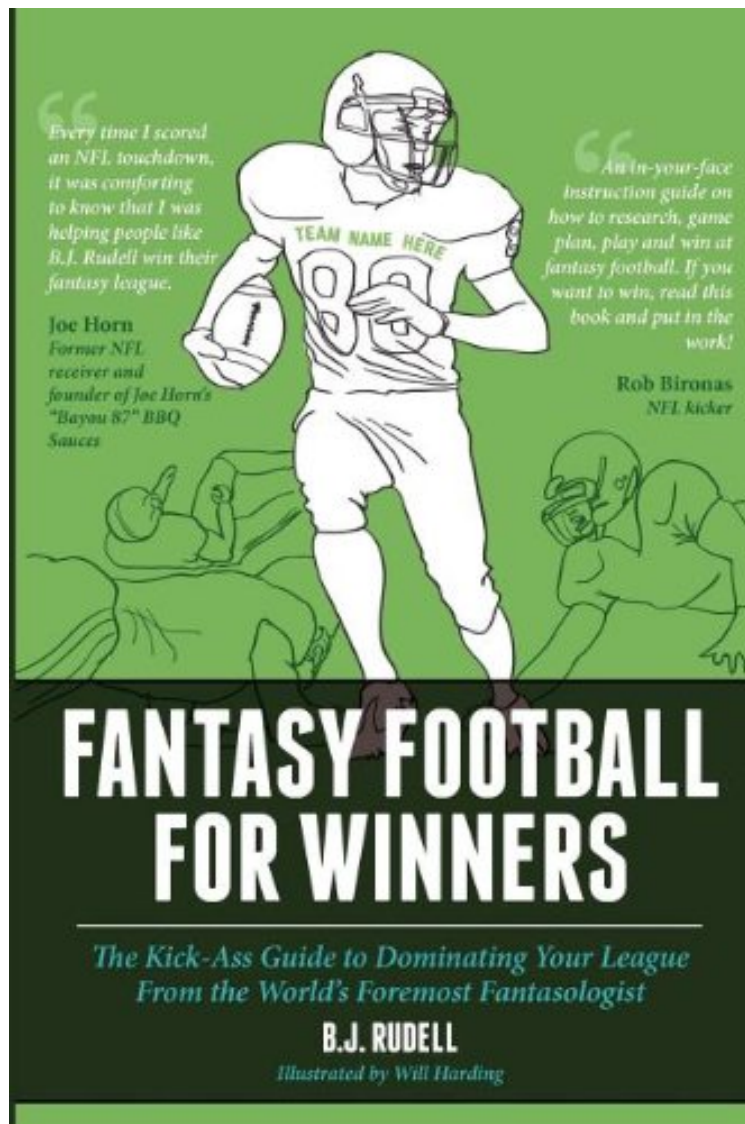

There is a lot of advice - like don't highly draft a defense! - that I already knew and found obvious but I bet a lot of people need to hear because they are not natural-born winners, but anyone can become a winner with enough dedication and commitment to not losing. It's mostly about attitude, and that's what this book has.He also promulgates a very useful system for preparing for the draft - the 10% part - but at the end of the day you're left to design your own stats-based ranking system in order to build your winning team. This is fine, because if fantasy football had been "solved" no one would play anymore. However, I'm skeptical that Mr. Rudell has not already solved the game and is just not telling all of his secrets in order to continue to profit from it. To that I say, keep winning!
