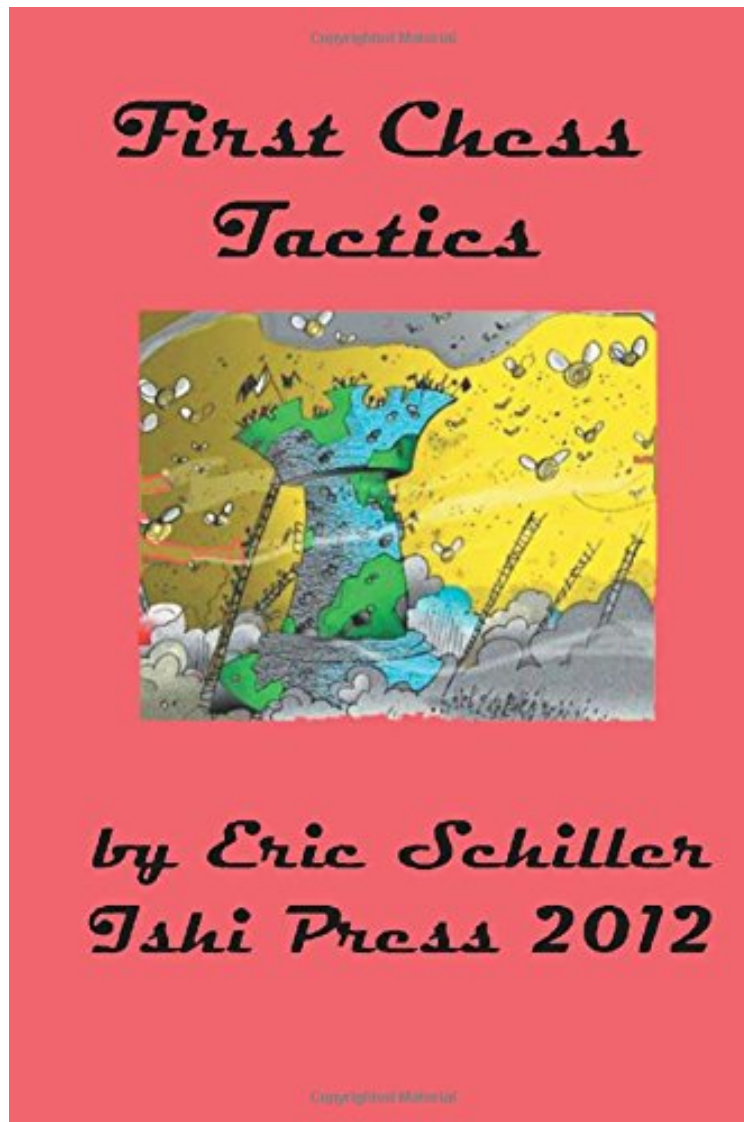

teacher for years and I can't see any use for this book. The BEST book by far for help with tactics is: Chess Camp, volume 6, a US Chess Federation book. The author is Igor Sukhin. It has several new tactics. I go through this book again and again. It has been very helpful in my chess playing.

This is a book of basic tactics for a beginner to learn. 144 diagrams illustrate common tactical situations.

About the Author The author is an international organizer for FIDE, and also an international arbiter most notably for the Kramnik-Kasparov World Championship match. Mr. Schiller also captained several Pan-American Intercollegiate teams, as well as the World Youth Championship in Chicago. Over-the-board accomplishments include obtaining the USCF Life Master, and FIDE Master titles. He won the 1974 Illinois State Championship, and the 1995 Calchess State Championship. Schiller has also established himself as a prolific and popular author of a wide range of chess books.
