This game has the added benefit of a poster used for some questions which makes it a little bit different and even more fun. The questions are fairly hard making this a game for adults but we aren't chefs or super serious foodies and still manage to answer a majority of them correctly or at least make educated guesses. There's a nice balance between the different categories too.
