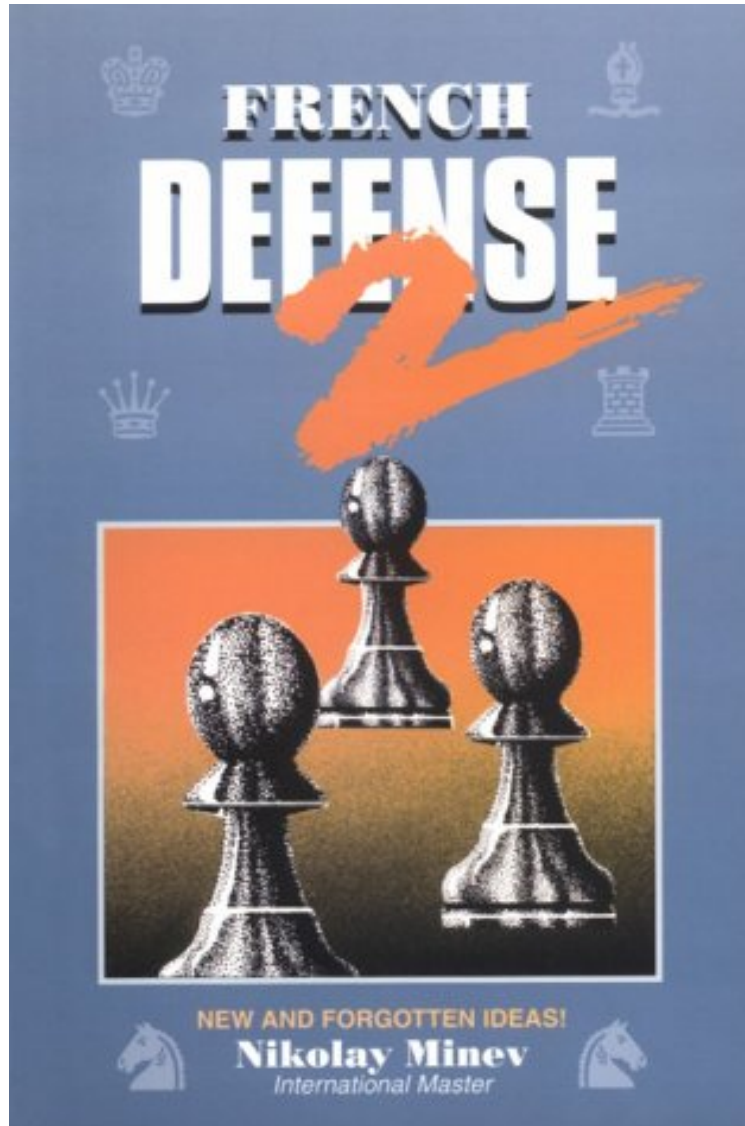

If you are an experienced French Player, this is an excellent book to get a few new ideas, and also to learn some of the opening mistakes that most other French books don't cover. Most of the miniatures end up won for White, so there are MANY traps that

Black can fall under in the French in the first 15 moves. There are also a few that White can fall into as well, and a couple of abandoned lines that could very well be sound. I wouldn't, however, recommend this book to a French Newbie, but get about a year or 2 of French experience under your belt and you are ready to dive into this book.

In its 2nd edition this book retains the basic idea of inspiring players to do independent work. Revised from the quick sellout 1988 edition, and greatly expanded, it offers 520 complete and instructive games with an additional 203 complete games included in the comments. There are: more than 1,000 forgotten ideas, suggestions, and improvements of theoretical book lines. The suggestions, practically speaking, are potentially new ideas for more independent analysis.

About the Author Dr. Minev, a French Defense connoisseur in addition to being an editor for the famous "Encyclopedia of Chess Openings" has published a tactics column in "Inside Chess" and is very accomplished in the endgame. He has published several openings' monographs. He resides in Seattle.
