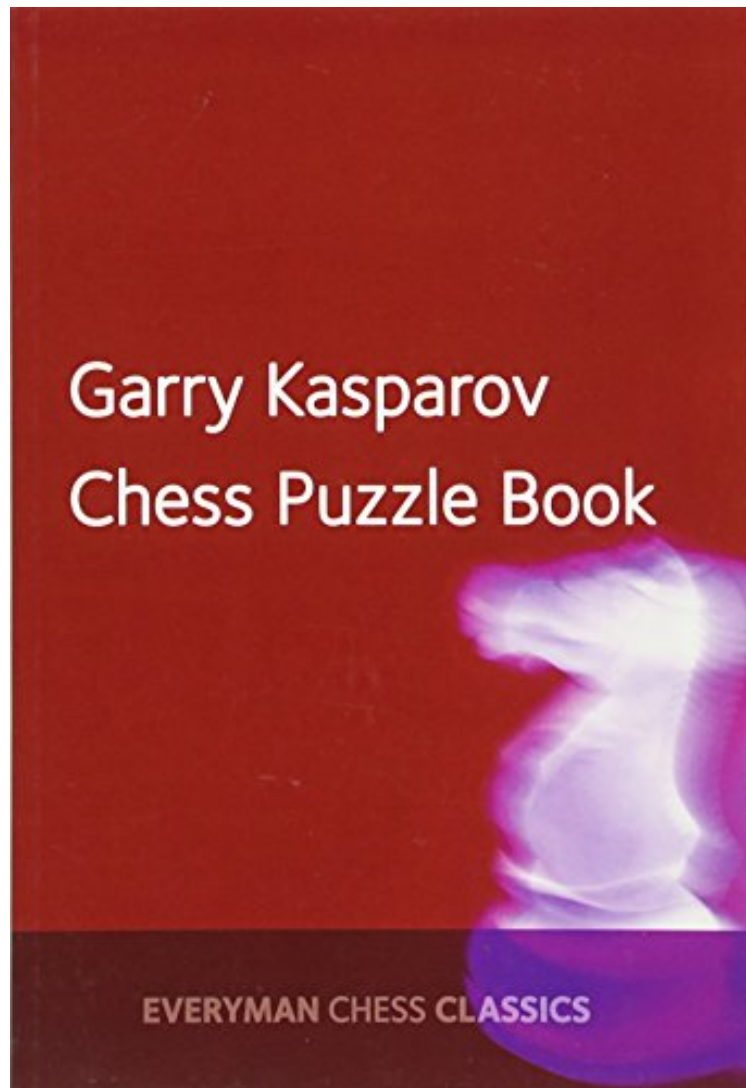

A VERY good book. The only drawback is that you know with which piece the combination starts with, which makes it sometimes too obvious the starting move order.
