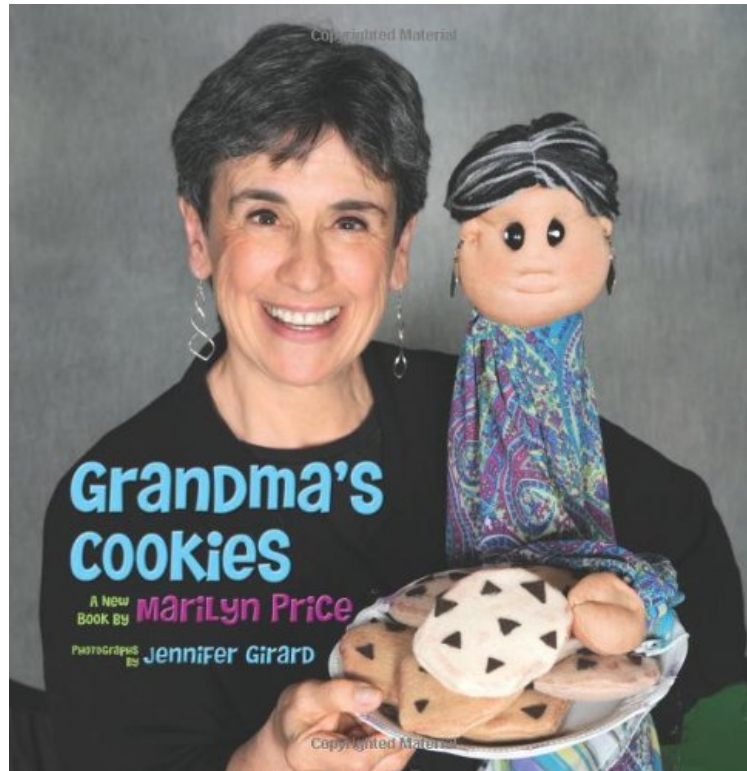

As for the story, it's not a reheated fairytale nor a futuristic vehicle, but a down-to-earth reminder that even kings need to love and be loved -- that's its main ingredient!The physical materials that the book is made of also make this a great book for taking to the beach or anywhere outdoors, because the covers are durable yet lightweight, not made of paper but of a plastic, so they're not heavy cardboard.
