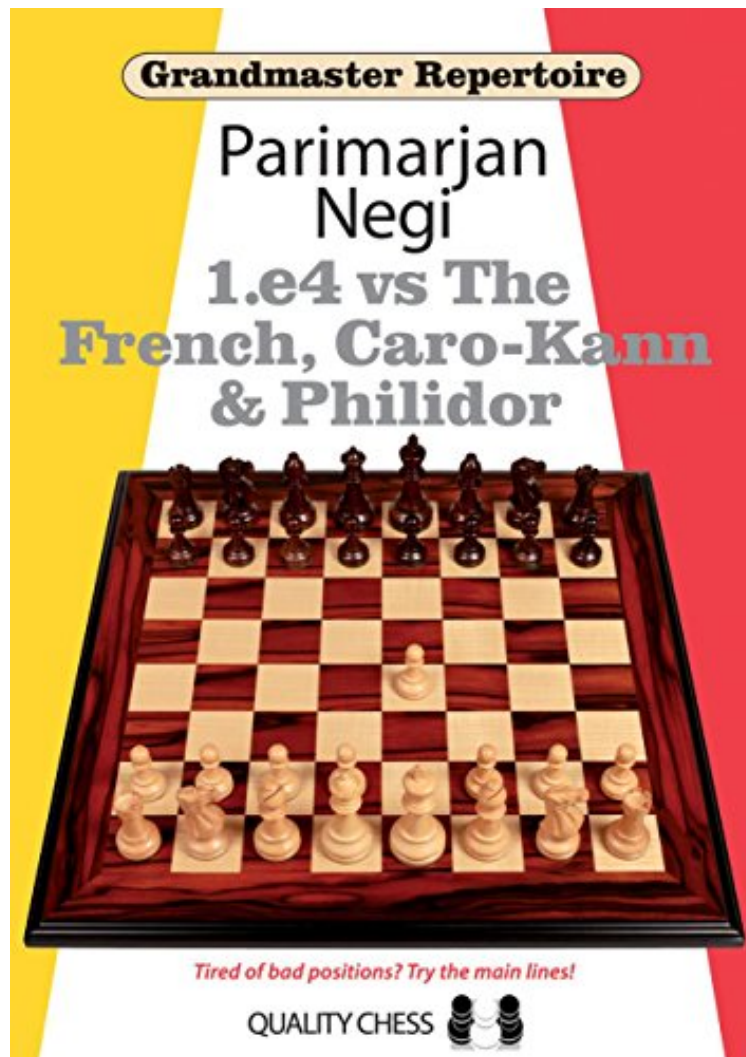

For instance, in chapter 9 Negi claims an advantage for white by ignoring Black's best move in crucial spots. Page 146 13...f6Page 147 after 15.Ne2 is just equalPage 151 he considers both 14...g6 and h6 but not f6! Both stockfish and Houdini rate 0.00On the whole white gets nothing with these recommendations against 7...a6Changing to four stars
