He has also published the list of 7-letter words (bingos) in 2006 and translated Stefan Fatsis Wordfreak into Greek (2007). Yannis Papavlassiou kept all Greek Scrabble tournament statistics and data for a long time, being a member of the Scrabble Club of Thessaloniki. He contributed to the tournament and club play for years.
