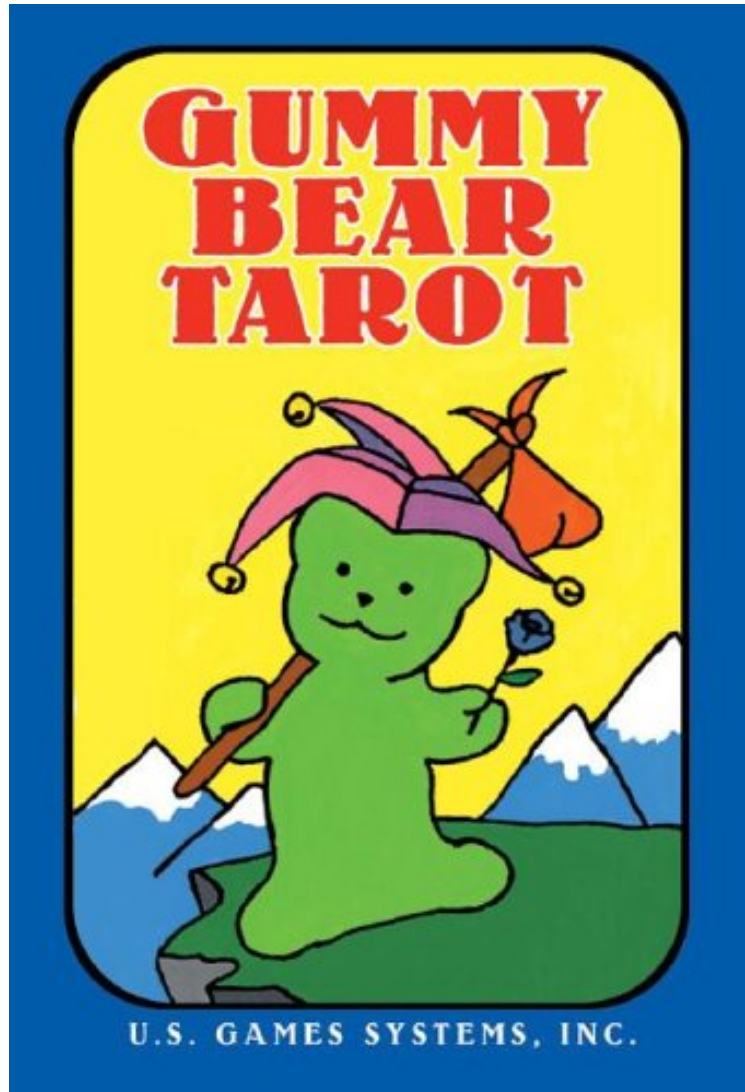

I've been using them for about 7 years now, and it is by far my favorite deck. They really resonate with me, and I connect with them on a deep level. The standard Rider Waite cards do not evoke good feelings in me, but I wanted something that still had the same symbolism so I could decipher meaning from the cards more easily. I was using a Lord of the Rings deck for about 7 years, but over time started to

lose connection with it and felt that the meaning would sometimes get lost in such a character-centric deck. I wanted something with the imagery of Rider Waite, but that I could connect with. When I found these cards, I knew right away I had to have them. I love bears and cute things, of course, but they still capture the right tone in each card without feeling overly cheerful or childish. They are smaller than any other tarot cards I've owned, and are about the size of a standard deck of playing cards. I actually like this for the fact that I have very small hands. The cardstock feels like good quality, although a bit thinner and lighter than other cards I've had, and they're easy to shuffle. They have lasted me years and still look new, so the size and thinness of the cards has proven to be a non-issue. They also come in a nice storage tin! Despite the lighthearted pictures, they read very accurately for me, and still give me the messages I need without sugar-coating anything.

I like to read with them occasionally, too, and *I* found this one to be pretty "chatty", if you know what I mean.
