It requires an ability to master difficult material, and BTW it is not permitted under ACBL's GeneralConventionChart, so

you probably have to be playing in the top bracket to play it. OTOH, the system offers lots of insights that are playable at all levels, such as how to never have to rebid a 2 or 3-card suit in the auction 1M-1N (M= either major). That alone is worth the price of admission IMHO. In addition, for Precision players, the material (in the 1D booklet) on how to deal with interference over 1D is also quite useful. If not all of these booklets are equally useful to you, some undoubtedly are if you are a student of bidding, and trying to improve your results. Book 1 may not contain enough material to affect your game, but in concert with the other books, it constitutes a logical introduction. In the end, you have to purchase multiple books to get the system, and that's probably what annoyed the other reviewer. I talked to a friend who played against the Granovetters at a recent national and he said (approximately). "It is not fun to play against the Granovetters. They have their system so down, and it is so good, that we were behind pretty much from the outset."
