A must-have for fans of Rin and LenBy SynchronicizedI bought this book sight unseen, as Rin Kagamine is my personal favorite among the Vocaloids and I knew I had to have it in my collection of artbooks.About the content: By the cover, one expects an artbook featuring the Kagamine twins and that's exactly what we get here. The book has 96 pages, and the overall format is quite similar to the Pixiv Almanac,

also released in North America by Udon. Namely, the book features a variety of artwork from approximately 50 different artists, each getting 1-4 pages to show off their work. I didn't know how much of the book would be devoted exclusively to Rin and Len, figuring that some of the other Vocaloids would also make appearances, and I was actually a bit surprised to find that there are very few cameos by the other Vocaloids. Hatsune Miku makes an appearance or two, but otherwise this is 100% Rin and Len. Like the Pixiv Almanac, there is very little text; each artist gets a paragraph or two to describe their take on the twins and a link to their homepage, but otherwise you will just find lots and lots of pretty pictures. Both twins are well represented. I'd say they appear together in about 70% of the pictures, about 20% feature Rin exclusively, and the remaining 10% or so feature Len exclusively. Generally, you'll find 1-4 illustrations per page, but there are about two dozen full-page pictures, and about a half-dozen large images that span two pages. Images range from original drawings, to materials which accompanied various Len and Rin songs/videos and even some beautifully drawn illustrations that serve as birthday greetings for Rin and Len! The book's construction: I've been very impressed with the quality of Udon's artbooks and this one is no exception. The pages are thick, the quality of the paper appears good, and even though the book is only 96 pages, it feels quite substantial when you're holding it in your hands. One thing that is not obvious by looking at the item listing is that the front and back covers have a very shiny silver finish. The finish is shiny enough that if you hold the book in front of you, you should be able to see your reflection in the cover. Thus, if you like to display your artbooks, this one might look pretty interesting sitting on the shelf. One minor complaint is that the book is quite thin, and sometimes it's a bit tricky to get a good look at the two-page illustrations; I'm not sure if the spine would crease easily, and I have no intention of finding out. Overall, I'd say that if you are a fan of either Kagamine twin, this book is certainly a worthwhile purchase. However, as I mentioned, the other Vocaloids are essentially absent, so you're getting exactly what you see on the cover. It's a really nice book, nice enough that I'll probably purchase Hatsune Miku Graphics: Character Collection CV01 - Hatsune Miku Edition and Hatsune Miku Graphics: Character Collection CV03 - Megurine Luka Edition as well. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
