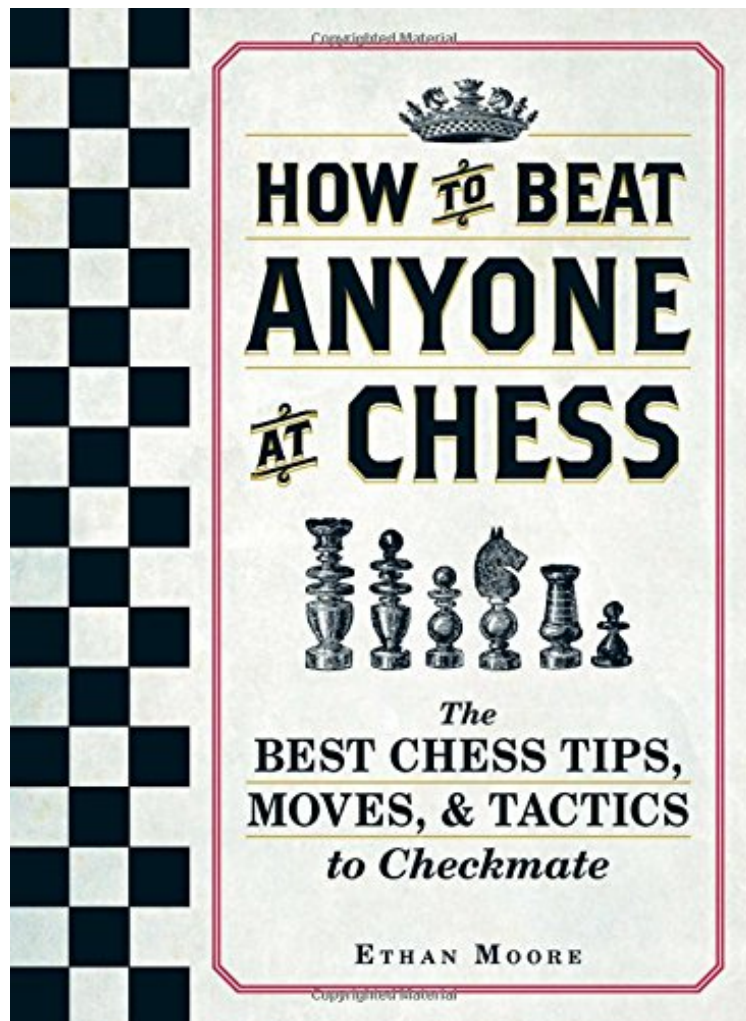

It reflects a deep understanding of both the game itself and the psychology of the player. Besides a good summary of fundamentals, topics are included not readily found elsewhere. mobile piece (after the queen)? (The answer is that this piece originally represented a chariot or a boat. In Russian it is still called that, and the bishop is called "elephant" (slon)).
