It uses 1/2-inch EMT aluminum tubing, three pulleys, a turnbuckle, a couple key rings, some fishing line, one or two rubber bands, a hinge and some miscellaneous hardware. No specialized tools are required, either. The arm extension is designed to work with the puppets you already have! The 4-inch hinged jaw fits inside the puppet where the thumb and fingers usually go. The basic idea is that the puppeteer manipulating the lever from below is able to open and close the mouth of the puppet above.
