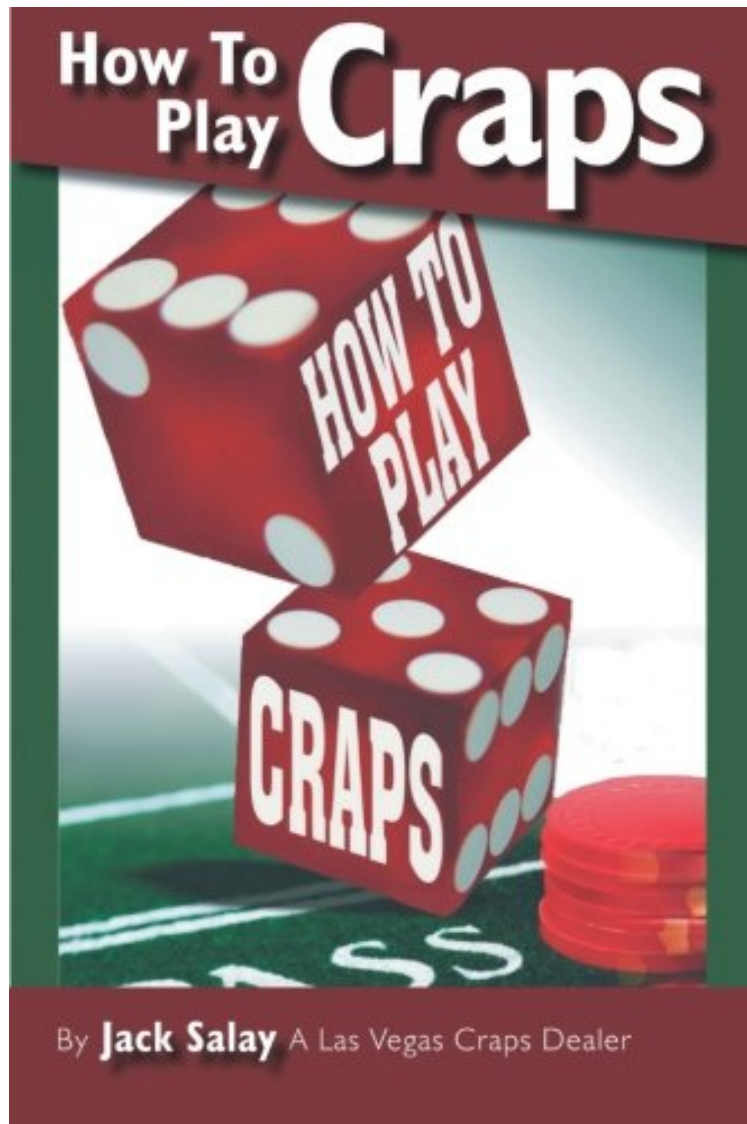

This might be due to the zillions of bets and odds that can be placed after the initial pass/don't pass. This is bare bones rules. don't buy it if you're looking for a way to beat the house. Reading this you probably will be able to place your bets to best advantage but you are just as likely going to end up at the rail with chips in your hand wondering where to lay them down.
