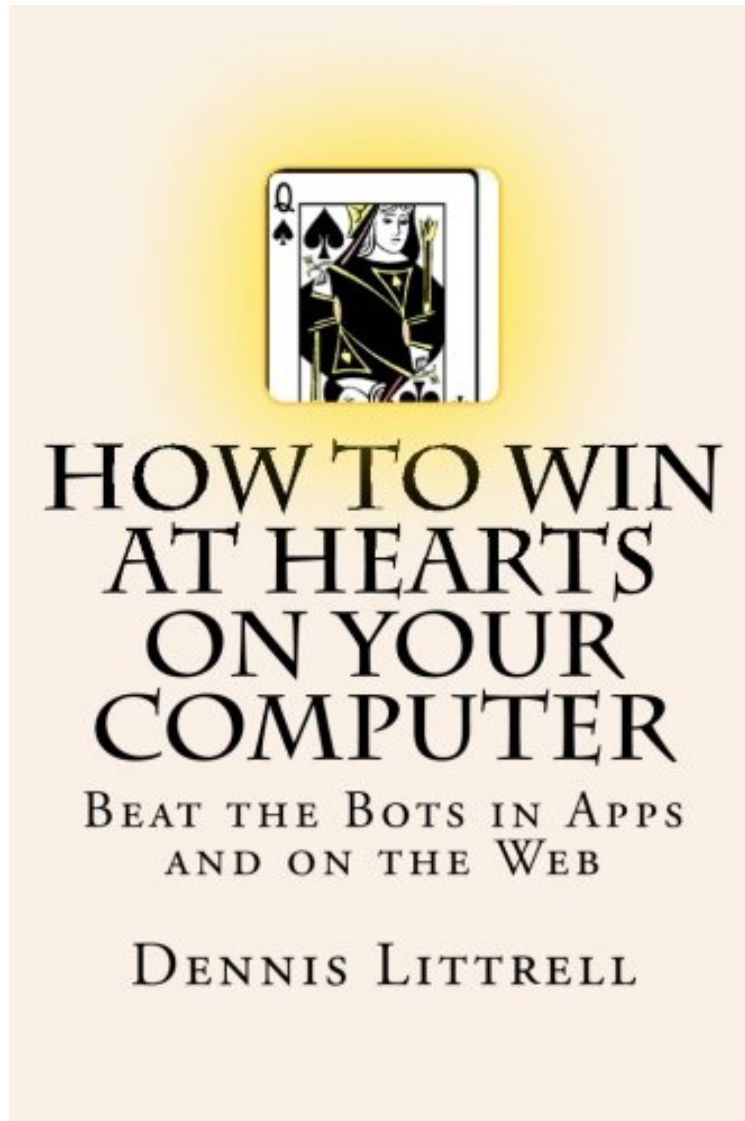

It is also the only hearts book that focuses on the Microsoft hearts game that comes with the Windows operating systems and on hearts game apps that you can play on handheld devices such as the Kindle, the Nook, the iPhone, etc. You'll learn how your robotic opponents think, what cards they are likely to pass to you, and what their tendencies are at various stages of the game.
