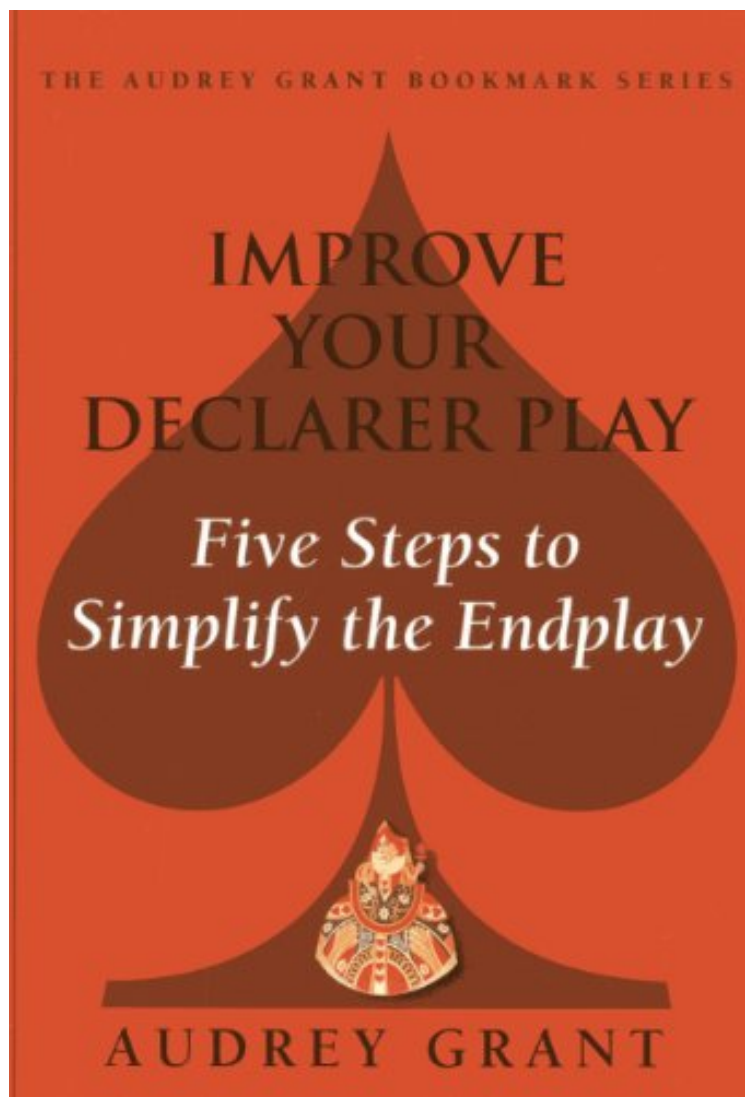

Fold-out bookmark flaps reference the essential ideas.
