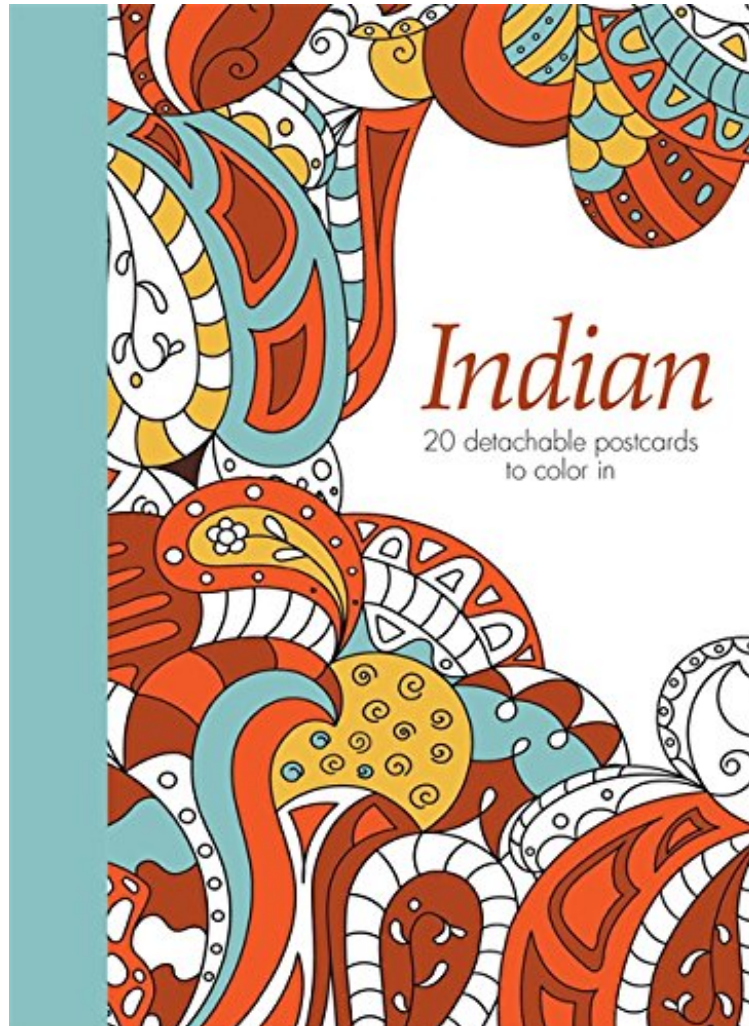

This is a lovely set of postcards, on super thick card stock. It is even heavier than the 110lb card stock that I use for printing coloring pages. I used gel pens, Pitt markers, Tombow markers, and none of them bled through. I also used watercolor pencils and an aqua brush with very little warping of the paper.The 20 designs have a nice variety in complexity too. Some are very simple, some have tiny detail. Each card measures 4.5x6.5", and has the standard postcard markings on the back. There are paisleys, mandalas, elephants, a dancer, and henna type designs. The printing and line art is very sharp and good quality.I have really enjoyed coloring these! I love

that these make a nice, quick project you can finish in an evening while watching TV. The only bummer is that they turn out so pretty that I'm afraid to mail them and let the postal service get them all dirty! 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
