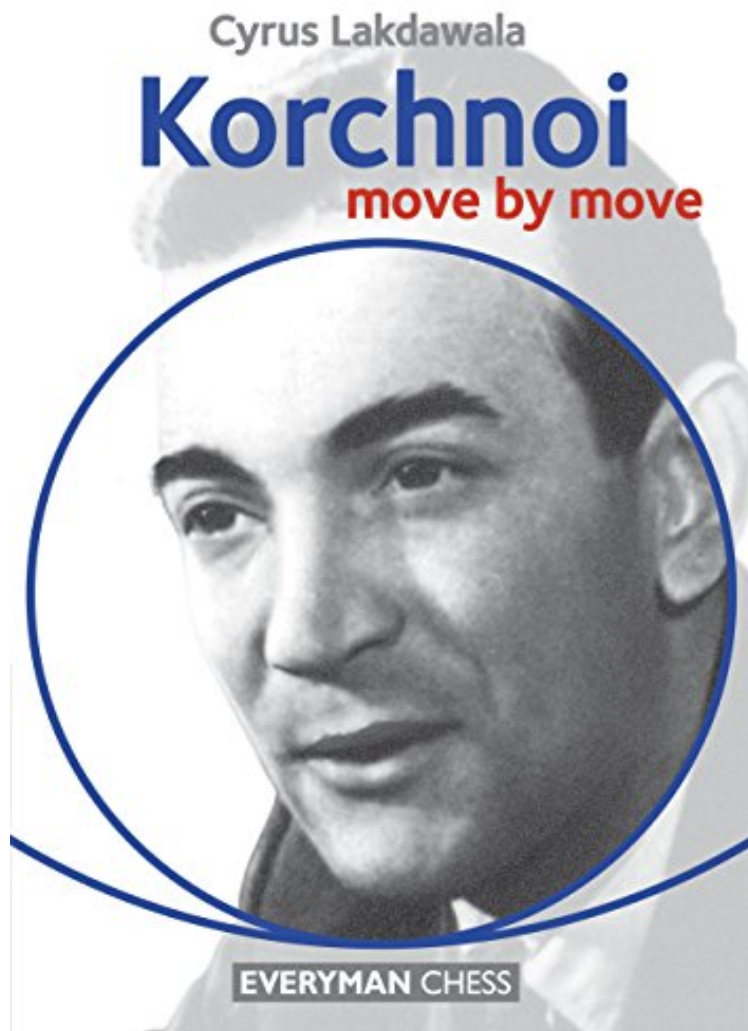

If you are unfamiliar with Everyman's "Move by Move" series, it is instruction aimed at the club player with a q a format (find the winning combination, etc.) with lots of diagrams and verbal commentary. I did quick comparison with Korchnoi's own My Best Games collection (which Cyrus cites in the bibliography and occassionally quotes from) and found that KMbM has 61 complete games spanning the years 1956-

2011 versus MBG's 110 games, 1950-2003. I compared games against World Champions and found Cyrus includes 22 while MBG has 11, with 8 games overlapping. Cyrus tends to stick to objective analysis aided by computer, but does drop in a few choice Korchnoi comments. For the French Defence aficionados, Cyrus includes 13 inspiring wins. Also included are 4 games played late in Korchnoi's career after 2003, including wins with Black over Gashimov and Caruana (talk about longevity!) If you are unfamiliar with Korchnoi's games (and if you play the English Opening or French Defence, you can't afford to be) this collection is a great place to start filling in the gap (especially, at the current ridiculously low price!) 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. Lakdawala's book has several positive features. For instance, the author discusses and explains the nuances behind reversed openings and subtle opening move orders such as the Sicilian, Players on both sides of the English opening will have a lot of material and opening transposition to deepen their understanding of this flexible opening. The annotations of all the games with Korchnoi on the black side of the French Defense are great (and worth the price of the book).
