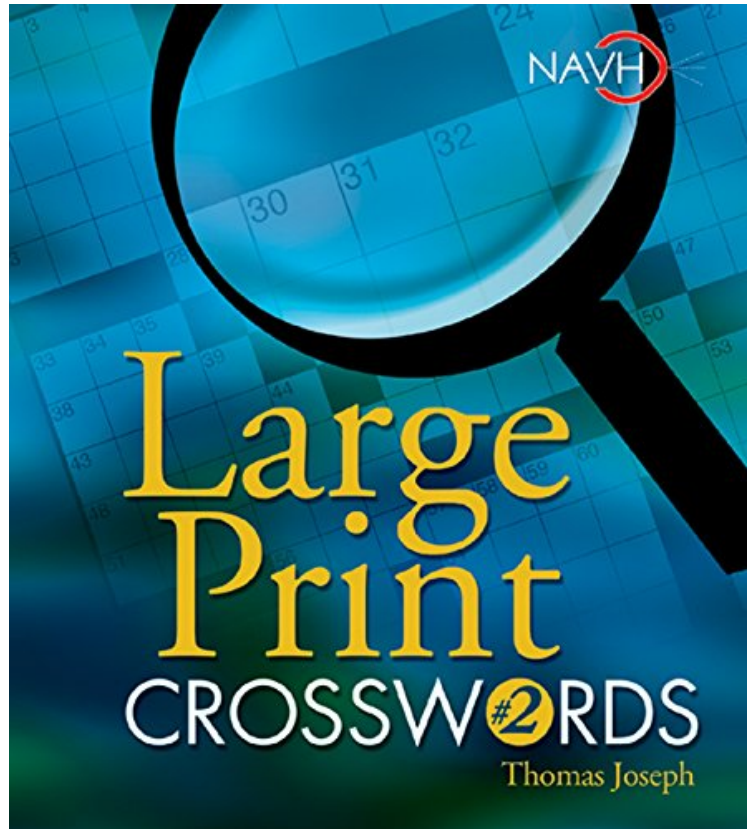

Also many names like authors, actors, titles etc. I'm not very good with names in the first place. Also many are 2 or more word answers which is kind of tricky and not very good for increasing your vocabulary as most are very small words. My grandmother is 94 years old and her eye's are starting to go. She loves doing puzzles and crosswords in the local newspaper, but she can no longer see the small text without a magnifying glass. She loves these large print crossword puzzles and says they vary in difficulty. I suspect that these large print crossword books are mostly used by older generations, but occasionally my grandmother calls to ask questions like "Who is the grandfather in the Simpsons?" or "Who wrote the Harry Potter series?" The book itself is a paperback with a ring binder. The questions and puzzle are on different pages, next to each other, which provides enough space for the large print. The

book is a bit bulky and has some weight to it, but it's overall design is good. There's also an answer section in the back. Pros: NAVH (National Association of Visually Handicapped) approved. Large Text Answers are included Cons: Answer section is not in any logical order which makes it hard to find answers to a particular puzzle.
