The images have been modified to gray tonalities, some darker for those who've not colored grayscale images, to lighter versions for the more advanced colorist. They are presented chronologically, so the lighter darker images are intermixed. If you are new to grayscale, do the darker images first. After coloring the darker one, go to the lighter images where you can employ more artistic freedom. All in all, you needn't be an 'artist' to colorize grayscale. You can simply color over a portion of the image with a single color the shading already on the page will give you very satisfying result.

I've chosen some vintage HOLLYWOOD images, pretty much family friendly, for your coloring pleasure. Breathe in the nostalgia evocative images from a more slowly paced lifestyle portrayed in this vintage, grayscale coloring book. I've developed these grayscale images for you with the tonal values in place. You add the color. Discover how your various pencils or crayons interact to create the colors you love. You don't have to do the shading. It's already there. Just apply a layer of color there's your picture! You'll find that even if you have only ONE red pencil, you can create many shades of red by using a blue, orange, purple underlay/overlay. Use as many layers as you wish. You're the colorist! If you choose gel pens, felt tips, or other more liquid mediums, please put a piece of cardstock or other paper behind your color work to catch any possible bleed through. You may want to cut out the pages to get a more open space to color. I always like to include a bit of whimsy. I love to give you something to smile about. Go ahead, frame your work! Put it on your walls or give as a gift. It's ART!!
