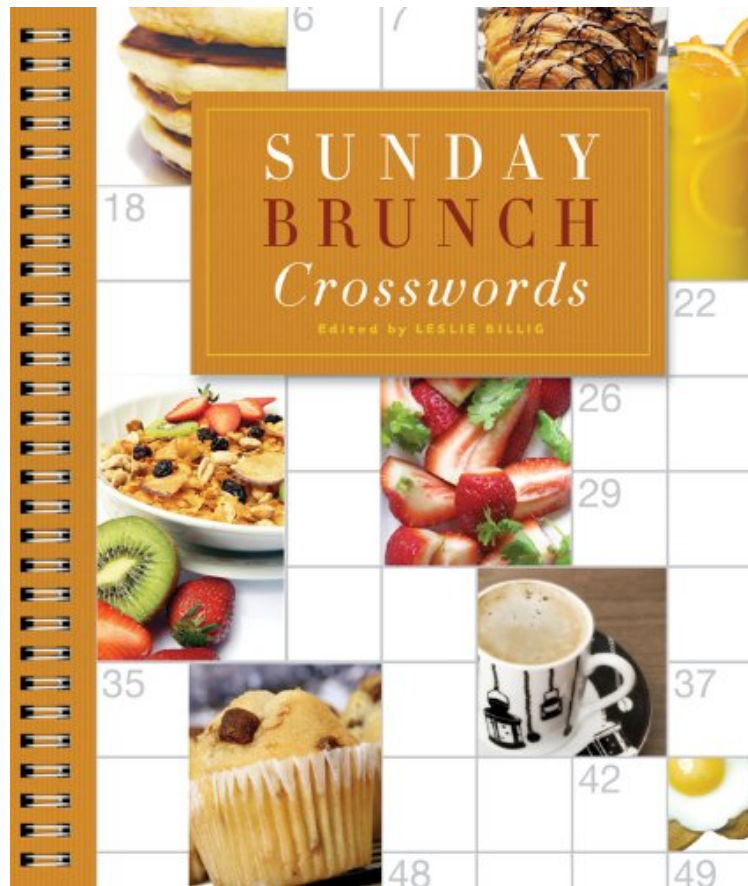

The facts are:1) printed on very good quality paper2) one puzzle plus clues per page3) print and squares large enough for older eyes4) individual leafs -- a puzzle on each side -- easily ripped from spiral binding5) superb editing: as far as I can remember, absolutely no typos6) hardly any gratuitously difficult clues: everything fair and above boardNow to the opinion: Just in case a crossword puzzle in any book or newspaper might be too easy, I work the puzzle as a sort of Scrabble; i.e., I can start the puzzle anywhere, but must play off existing words only and can't begin again elsewhere on the puzzle until I'm absolutely stumped and can no longer play off what I have already written in. (Yes, I use ink.) I estimate that I became "stumped" in fewer than one out of five puzzles. I do not consider these especially easy, but neither are they terribly difficult. Perhaps a few are challenging. Some have clever gimmicks. Just about every one is fun.
