I reviewed it kind of hard only because I really love the first STREET FIGHTER universe and I am one of the franchise's biggest fans who had some high expectations! Plus, I got really

tired of the same ol' "dark hado" storyline. I mean UDON STUDIOS outdid themselves with the first series of STREET FIGHTER comics and graphic novels. Yet, I never should have doubted UDON STUDIOS. Volume 1 was merely a slow set-up for this book right here! I can't believe that I'm about to say this but....SUPER STREET FIGHTER- VOLUME 2: HYPER FIGHTING is piping-hot awesomeness with a side-order of "awww, snaps"! So many great fights! Lots of drama and crazy-mad action! Amazing signature moves! Superb manga/anime artwork with some sweet backgrounds! This is off the hook, kid! I've read this book 15 times and can't put it down! Dude, UDON STUDIOS has artistically and brilliantly soaked the whole STREET FIGHTER comic book universe in CAPCOM gasoline and then burned this mother so hot that the fans can see it for miles and miles, son! OOOOH!...I really loved the BONUS STAGE stories in the book, with the exception of the DAN HIBIKI one (please, UDON, no more DAN HIBIKI stories)! My favorites were HONG KONG HUSTLE (starring SEAN, CHUN-LI, and KEN MASTERS) and SQUARED CIRCLE SLAM (starring R. MIKA, HUGO, and POISON)! If anyone from UDON STUDIOS is reading my review, please do me a super-huge favor and make the BONUS STAGE stories even longer! They totally rocked! The Rise of Gill and the Secret Society By David Swan I was almost immediately confused at the beginning of this story. It showed Juri working for Seth and S.I.N with Seth working against the Secret Society that includes Gill and M. Bison. So now we are mixing Street Fighter IV and Street Fighter III. Meanwhile, Akuma is trying to corrupt Ryus pupil Sakura with the Dark Hado. The Super Street Fighter series takes place in the SF III time period with Gill and Urien as the main villains. We also get a lot of bleed-over with SF IV including the appearance of Akuma's final form, Oni. The story here doesn't quite mesh with the plot of SF V but that's not shocking given that SF V was released after this story was written. As with volume 1, volume 2 has a lot of filler that has nothing to do with the main storyline. We get a fight featuring Sean and Chun Li against some street thugs. The story spends a lot of time on Dan Hibiki, who was created as a joke character and remains so. There is a fight between Rainbow Mika and Poison with Hugo in Poisons corner. All of these are just interludes that could have been removed without affecting the main storyline. I had hoped that since this series takes place in the SF III time period that we would get more appearances by SF III characters but this didn't occur. There are no appearances by Elena, Oro, Makoto, Q or Remy and the appearances by Hugo, Dudley, Yun and Yang are outside of the main storyline. I always enjoy the art from Udon and the only part that I thought fell short was the fight between Gill and Urien which looked pretty weak. I didn't even understand what happened in the fight. Urien was winning and then all of a sudden Gill inexplicably transforms into his godlike red/blue state. Gill is so powerful that he can take out Oni and Dark Ryu at the same time without breaking a sweat. That seems a bit overboard. The one nice thing is that Gill is considerably different from the megalomaniacal M. Bison rather than just a rehash. My biggest disappointment is that this volume has no conclusion. Volume 1 was released in 2013 and volume 2 in 2015 so we may have to wait until 2017 for volume 3. There is a lot less bonus art than in volume 1 and the total length of the book is only 128 pages. Street Fighter Unlimited will be released very soon and will also take place in the SF III time period. I'm curious to see if it is a continuation of the story here or something entirely different. Either way I hope it focuses more on SF III and less on other periods. I don't regret getting this book in the least but it certainly wasn't everything I had hoped it would be. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Not the best one...
