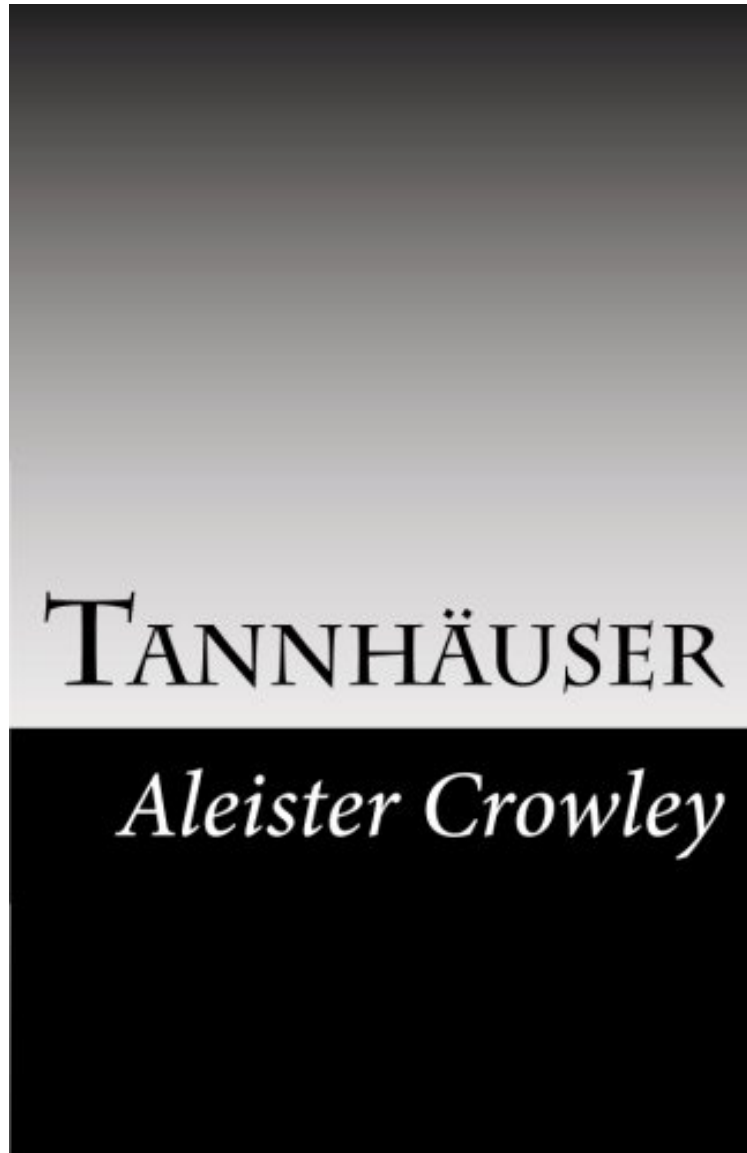

Gardner's Book Of Shadows. What this IS, however, is a segmented Gordon Press edition from 1974. They took the individual poems and plays from Crowley's 3-volume "Collected Works" and published each in a separate hardback volume. Dozens of volumes, each an unnumbered limited edition of 200. Many Crowley collectors think these editions are rip-offs. I don't recommend them. 1 of 2 people found the following review helpful. Terrible transcription of the original, numerous spelling and formatting errors. By Customer Numerous errors in the text, it's like whoever created the file just ran the original through some sort of text recognition software, and it did a terrible job.
