Now after almost 20 years, I started playing again and wanted some books to help refresh the memory. This book is great in teaching techniques and principles for declarer's play. Very concise, to the point, the scenarios and solutions are quite practical and can be applied to your game with some practice. I would definitely recommend this book to anyone, not just newbies, but also experienced players. So why one star then, you may ask? Well, while the content of the book is excellent, the quality of the book as a product is terrible. I'm about 55 pages into the book, 30+ pages already fell off! Maybe it was because of the cheap glue the book used, or bad quality control (is there such thing of quality control for books). In any case, this is the first time I have problem like this reading a book as far as I remember. I'm a very gentle reader, never fold a book or page, always close the book using a bookmark after reading. Content being excellent makes this problem even more annoying. Terrible product! For *Advanced Bridge Players Only* By Davis 18 Eddie Kantar has written some great bridge books for novices and intermediates, but this book from 40 years ago is definitely only for very advanced players. Of the 100 bridge problems, Kantar himself in the Foreword describes the last 50 as being very challenging or catering to experts. Although Kantar's famous humor is on display - as in his answer to one tricky problem, when he says, If you had trouble with this one, this may not exactly be the right book for you. This was one to give you confidence! This is not the right book for anyone below the level of advanced intermediate.
